












STUDERITS Say Rate your overall feelings in regards to the implementation of Chromebooks this year. (May 2016)




Being able to communicate with my teachers more outside of school--this change has been extremely helpful.

It's easier to collaborate with other students on things because of the ability to share documents with people.




How often do your students use Chromebooks during class? (November 2015)









In how many of your classes do you use your Chromebook daily?








